

# Radio Equipment Directive Explained

## Why attend?

The new Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU has been published in the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU) replacing the Radio and Telecommunications Terminal Equipment (R&TTE) Directive 1999/5/EC.

From the 13 June 2017 all equipment within scope must be declared to the RED.

## Who should attend?

This course will be useful for Design Engineers, Compliance Engineers, Test Engineers and Managers responsible for products that have a radio interface.

Key aspects of this new Directive:

- The RED 2014/53/EU brings the Directive into line with the New Legislative Framework (NLF).
- The RED introduces obligations for importers and distributors of radio equipment.
- Broadcast receivers are now included within the scope of the RED.
- Telecommunications Terminal Equipment which had no radio interface are no longer within the Directive's scope, but instead are within the scope of the Low Voltage Directive (LVD) 2014/35/EU and the Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) Directive 2014/30/EU.
- Market surveillance activities are being increased to ensure that non-compliant products are more easily identified and removed from the market.
